New Testament Principles

- A) Laying aside falsehood, speak the truth, each one of you, with his neighbor (Ephesians 4:25).
- B) Flee sexual immorality. Every sin that a man does is outside the body, but he who commits sexual immorality sins against his own body (1 Corinthians 6:18).
- C) For all that is in the world—the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life—is not of the Father but is of the world (1 John 2:16).
- D) Yet for us there is one God, the Father, of whom are all things, and we for Him; and one Lord Jesus Christ, through whom are all things, and through whom we live (1 Corinthians 8:6).
- E) Little children, guard yourselves from idols (1 John 5:21).
- F) Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right (Ephesians 6:1).
- G) Knowing this: that the law is not made for a righteous person, but for the lawless and insubordinate, for the ungodly and for sinners, for the unholy and profane... (1 Timothy 1:9a).
- H) Let him who steals steal no longer; but rather let him labor (Ephesians 4:28).
- I) Now if you...murder, you have become a transgressor of the law (James 2:11).
- J) No New Testament Commandment: So let no one judge you in food or in drink, or regarding a festival or a new moon or sabbaths (Colossians 2:16).
