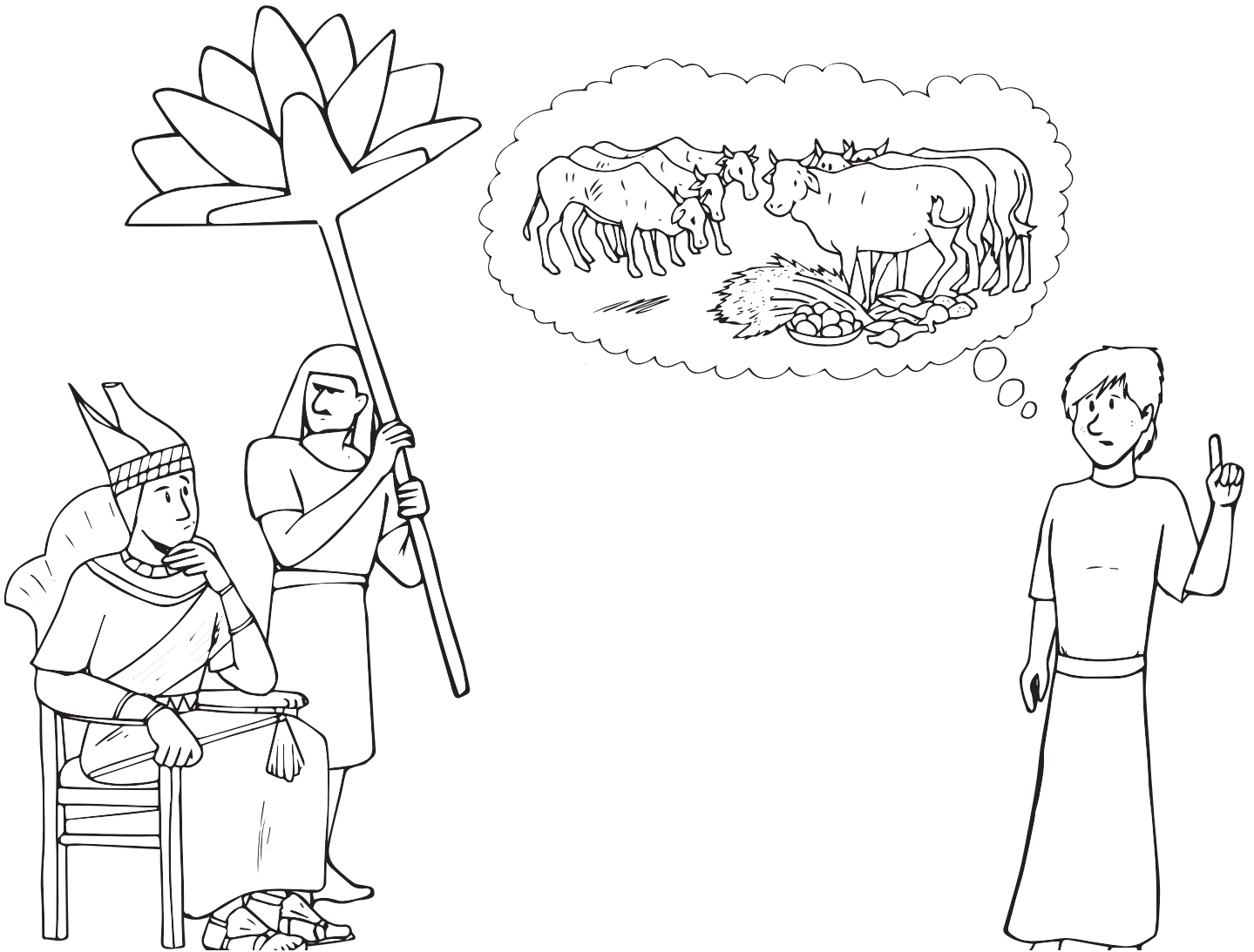

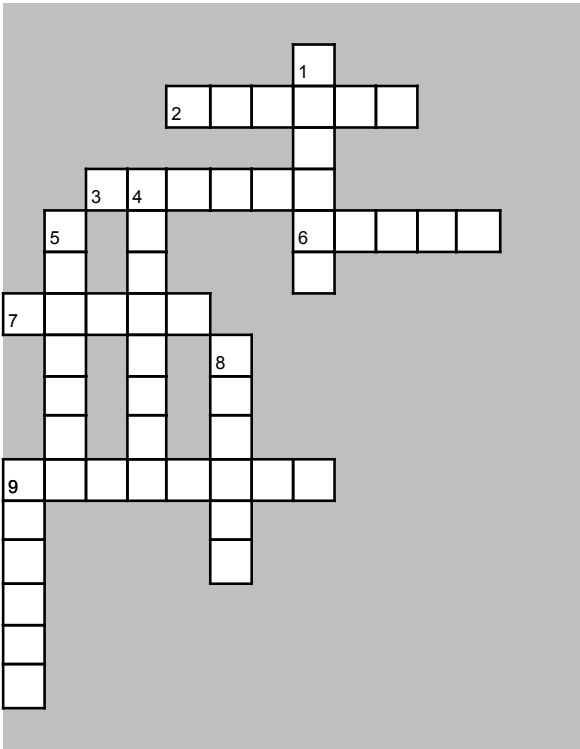

# Joseph Interprets Dreams Crossword Puzzle

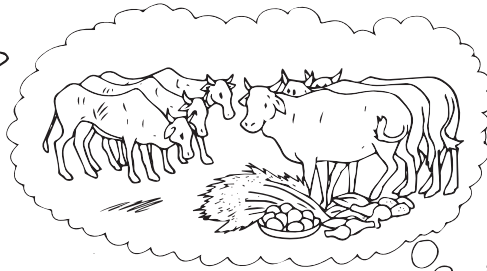

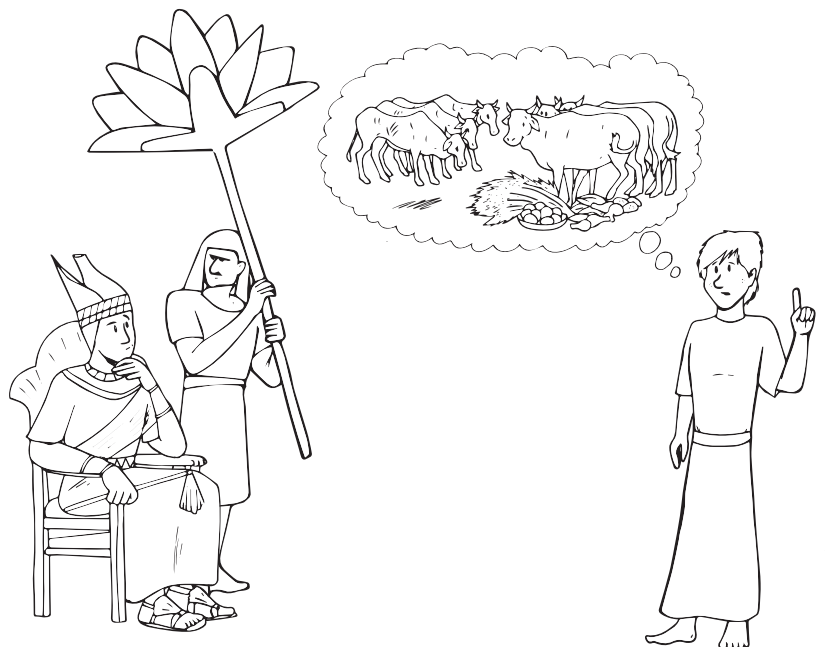
