

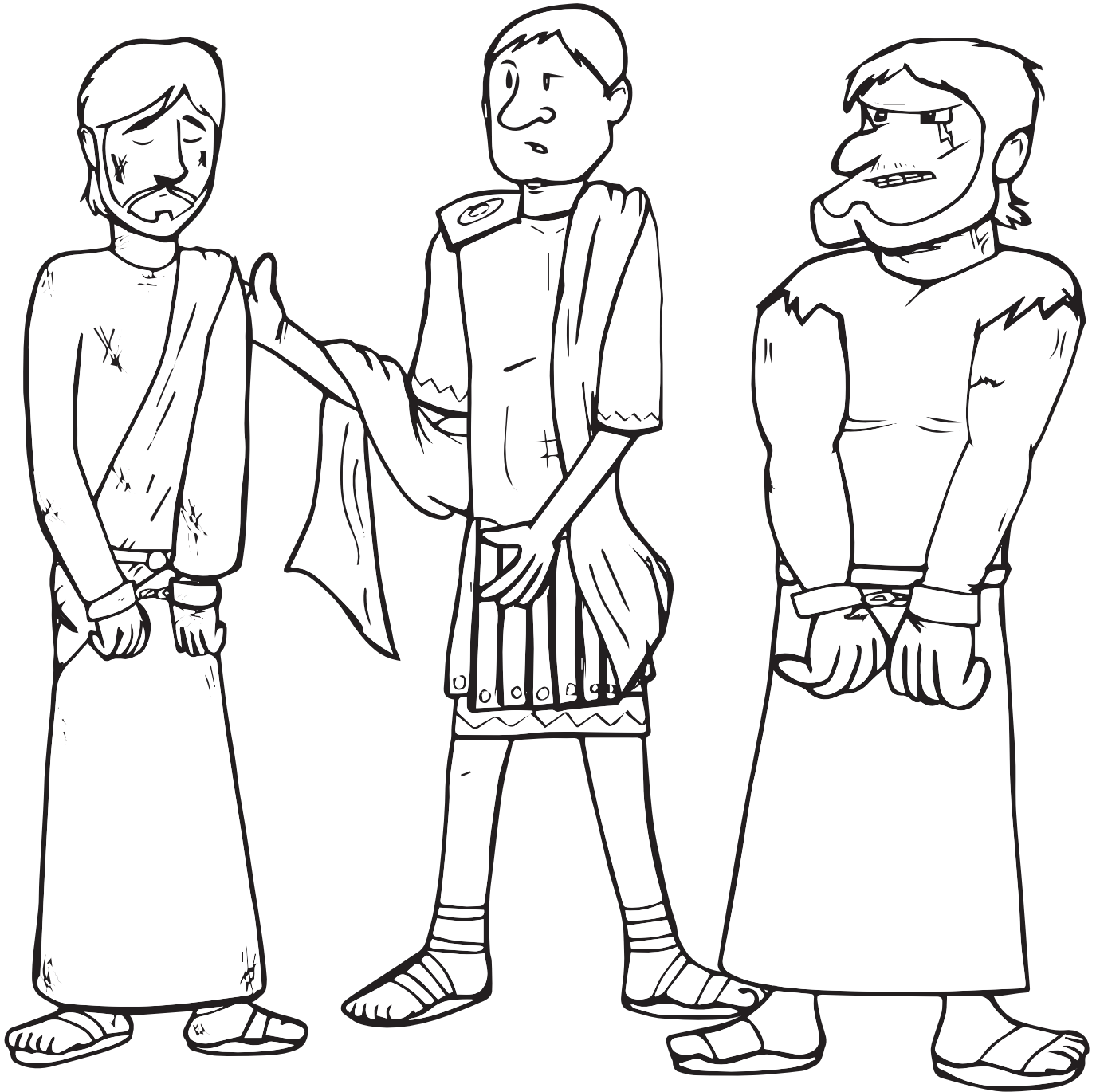

# Jesus' Trial and Crucifixion

“Now at the feast he was accustomed to releasing one prisoner to them, whomever they requested. And there was one named Barabbas, who was chained with his fellow rebels; they had committed murder in the rebellion. Then the multitude, crying aloud, began to ask him to do just as he had always done for them. But Pilate answered them, saying, ‘Do you want me to release to you the King of the Jews?’ ... But the chief priests stirred up the crowd, so that he should rather release Barabbas to them” (Mark 15:6-11).

\_\_\_\_\_ Judas led a group of people to the Garden of Gethsemane and kissed Jesus' cheek.

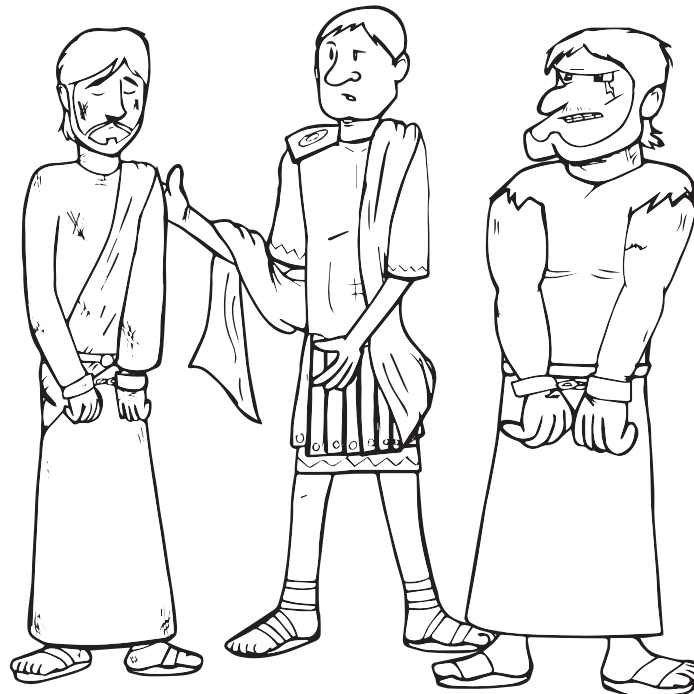
\_\_\_\_\_ Jesus was taken to Caiaphas.
