




Jesus' Resurrection Chronological Activity

Instructions: Place the events in order using the information you learned from this lesson. Pilate sent soldiers to guard the tomb and seal it with wax to prevent it from being opened by anyone. Jesus suffered six hours on the cross. The women went to the tomb to finish preparing Jesus' body, but found the tomb had been opened by an earthquake and only angels and the linens that Jesus' body had been wrapped in remained. Forty days later, Jesus returned to heaven. Joseph and Nicodemus started preparing Jesus' body and laid it in the tomb. The angels told the women to go and tell the apostles that Jesus had risen from the dead. Many of His disciples did not believe He had risen until Jesus appeared to them and showed them His hands and feet where the nails had been driven. Jesus, along with the help of Simon, carried the cross to the Hill of Golgotha.
