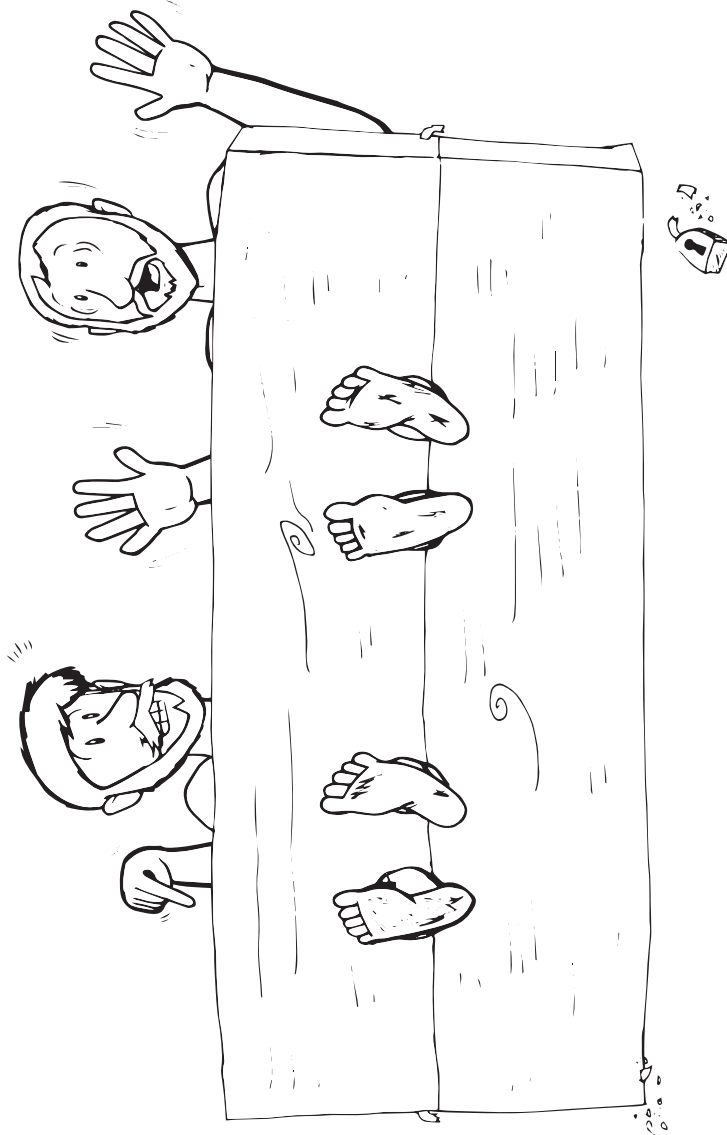

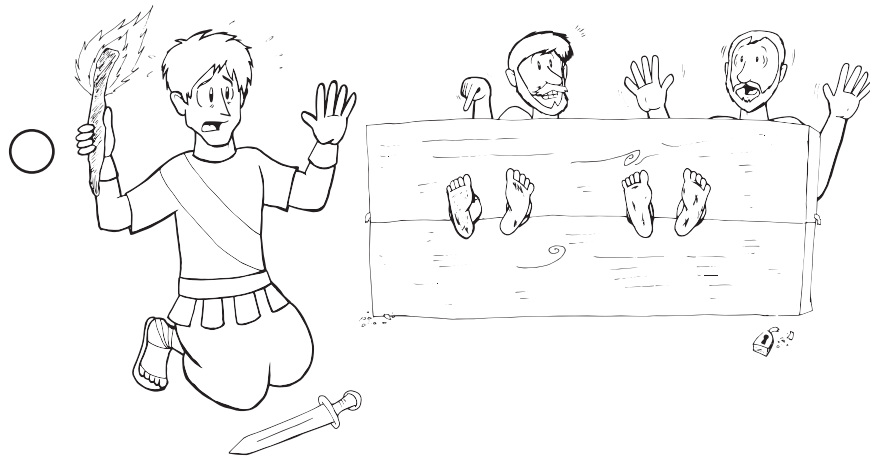
# Philippian Jailer Coloring Sheet

## Saved Man Activity Questions

- 1) What question did the Philippian jailer ask in Acts 16:30?  
[“Sirs, what must I do to be saved?”]
- 2) Based on Acts 16:30-33, how do we know that we have to actually “do” something to be saved? [Paul and Silas said that the jailer had to do something to be saved.]
- 3) In Acts 16:31, what did Paul and Silas say the jailer needed to do to be saved? [“Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ”]
- 4) What is said in Acts 16:32 that indicates that Paul and Silas taught the jailer what “believing on the Lord Jesus Christ” means? [After saying that he had to believe on Jesus to be saved, “they spoke the word of the Lord to him.”]
- 5) Based on Acts 16:33, how do we know that the jailer repented of his sins? [He washed Paul and Silas’ wounds from the beatings they had received.]
- 6) Based on Acts 16:31,33-34, how do we know that “believing on the Lord Jesus Christ” includes being baptized? [Paul and Silas said to “believe,” and the jailer responded by being baptized. After being baptized, verse 34 says that what the jailer had done was “believing in God.”]
- 7) What clue in Acts 16:34 helps us to see that the jailer was not forgiven of his sins until after being baptized? [He did not rejoice until after his baptism.]
- 8) The jailer and “all his family were baptized.” Based on Acts 16:31-32, how do we know that did not include babies? [Those who were saved had to be able to be able to believe. Also, they had to be able to hear and understand the words that Paul and Silas preached to them.]
